EQUIPMENT LIST FOR FAIR WEATHER CAMPING TRIPS

Use this list in conjunction with the one in the *Scout Handbook for Boys*.

If you are unfamiliar with any item, please consult with one of the troop leaders before acquiring it. Remember to mark your son's name on each item.

NECESSARY:

THE COMPLETE OFFICIAL SCOUTS BSA UNIFORM

Scout Handbook for Boys

Base layer (long johns top and bottom) for cool weather camping (not 100% cotton)
Canteen or water bottle
Change of clothing for each day
Headlamp (or flashlight) w/ fresh or extra batteries
Mess kit or similar (bowl / plate / cup)
Pen and paper
Poncho or rain suit
Shoes / sneakers / moccasins as an extra pair
Shoes, waterproof to wear
Sleeping bag in waterproof bag (or several blankets)
Sleeping pad or air mattress
Socks, hiking - 2 pr. (wool, SmartWool, CoolMax, etc.)
Socks, synthetic thin (nylon or polypropylene or similar) - 2 pr.
Sweater / sweatshirt / light jacket
Toilet kit
Towel and washcloth
Utensil kit or similar (knife / fork / spoon)
Waterproof ground cloth to place under the sleeping bag.
Windbreaker / nylon shell / anorak

OPTIONAL:

First Aid Kit
Backpack
Bandanna
Bible or other religious reading material
Compass
Hiking boots
Pocketknife (only for Scouts who have earned their Totin' Chip card.)
